## Terms & Conditions

The following terms and conditions are governed by English law, and are subject to the jurisdiction of the English courts. It is agreed that the following terms represent the entire agreement made between You ("the Client") and Miranda Virgo ("the Photographer"), and that no variation or modification of this agreement shall be effective unless agreed in writing.

**Booking & Fees** The Booking Fee of 25% secures the date, time and services of the Photographer for the Wedding or Civil Partnership ("the Wedding"). This is non-refundable or transferable in the event that you cancel or change the booking. It is agreed that the Booking Fee represent the liquidated damages suffered by the Photographer if you cancel prior to 7 days before the Wedding. In the event that you cancel less than 7 days before the Wedding, you agree to pay the entire fee due (TOTAL Fee). All cancellations must be in writing. Where the Wedding is postponed, the Photographer at her sole discretion may allow the fees to be transferable to a new date provided the Photographer can accommodate the change. Following payment of the Booking Fee, the balance of fees due must be paid on the day of viewing after the Wedding or within 21 days of the Wedding unless otherwise agreed.

**Compliance with Venue Rules** The Photographer is limited by the guidelines, policies and rules of your chosen venue ("Venue Rules"). These can sometimes restrict the position and use of certain equipment such as flash or where and when the Photographer can stand or take photographs. The Client agrees to accept the technical results of the imposition of these Venue Rules on the Photographer and the impact they may have on the quality of the photographs. If you can negotiate special terms with the venue to waive certain rules, it is your responsibility to notify the Photographer and venue staff of this agreement. If on the day, the Photographer is instructed by venue staff contrary to your understanding, then the Photographer will accept this to be the position on the day.

**Photographic Media & Backups** The Photographer may adjust the size, colour and balance of the Photographs, but cannot guarantee exact matching of any specified requirements. In the case of artistic images the colours, sizes and textures used will be subject to the Photographer's exclusive artistic interpretation. All photographs will be delivered on a CD or DVD in JPG/JPEG format unless otherwise agreed. You are responsible for verifying that the media is not corrupt, making and securing appropriate backups as soon as possible and notifying the Photographer of any media problems within 14 days from delivery. You are further reminded that electronic media such as CDs and DVDs have a shelf life and will eventually degrade to the point where the media is unreadable. You should consider appropriate electronic backups that mitigate this. You agree that you are entirely responsible for sourcing and printing any photographs or albums unless this is agreed to be part of the service.

The Photographer will make reasonable efforts to keep a copy of your photographs on non-resilient media for up to three months, after which time they may be deleted. If you require a duplicate copy of your CD, DVD or USB memory stick, the Photographer reserves the right to charge a fee of £25 for time and materials.

Prints – Where Prints are supplied as part of the package, these will be produced on photographic quality paper to the highest standards available on the Photographer's printing equipment or chosen printing outlet. Your attention is drawn to the fact that all photographs will, in time, fade. This is particularly true if they are exposed to bright sunlight. The Photographer cannot accept any responsibility for this deterioration. All Prints purchased are presumed to have been received in good condition unless the Client notifies the Photographer in writing of any problem within 14 days of receipt.

**License, Right to Use & Copyright** The Photographer retains all Copyright and intellectual property for the photographs, design, art and associated methods. **Upon payment of all fees due, the Client shall be granted a non-exclusive, non-assignable, royalty free, perpetual license to use, reproduce, print, copy, modify and distribute the supplied photographs for your non-commercial use. This excludes sale, or supply for any commercial purposes unless otherwise agreed in writing by the Photographer.**

Creative and Artistic Photography – The Photographer shall be granted artistic freedom in relation to the poses photographed, the location used and digital retouching. The Photographers' judgment regarding the locations, poses and number of photographs taken shall be deemed to be correct. Retouching and artistic finishing is at the Photographer's discretion.

Display - For the purposes of Section 87 of the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988 the Client agrees that the Photographer may use any images produced in their studio, web site, portfolio, literature, display areas, exhibitions, competitions, advertising, slide shows or commercially. The Client may withdraw this consent at a future time, by notifying the Photographer in writing.

**Limitation of Liability** Force Majeure or Act of God – Performance of these services are subject to alteration or cancellation by the Photographer owing to any cause beyond their control (e.g. acts of God, change in legislation, floods, fire, computer or equipment failure, etc). In the unlikely event of total equipment failure or cancellation of this contract by the Photographer, the Photographer's liability shall be limited to a full refund of fees paid. In the unlikely event of the Photographer being unable to attend your Wedding due to unforeseen circumstances, the Photographer reserves the right to appoint another photographer to attend your Wedding to perform the service agreed to his / her best ability.

Notwithstanding legislation to the contrary, in the unlikely event that either the Client or the Photographer fail to perform their obligations the liability of one party to the other shall be limited to the total value of the contract. Neither party shall be liable for indirect, consequential loss or any claims from 3rd parties.
